A **Community of Practice** is a group of people who share a common interest in a specific issue who meet via the internet to collaborate over an extended period to share knowledge, experience, ideas, success stories, challenges and resources. Together the community learns from each other, develops new knowledge, finds solutions and builds innovations.

The **Global Community** on Health Worker Migration links to a library of resource materials, a calendar of events, announcements, discussion board, and an automatic archive of every email and document.

Each global dialogue lasts for a limited period of time. All contributions are acknowledged. Participants receive one email per day that contains a daily digest of the discussion.
